a warm welcome and an inclusive, friendly, non-threatening atmosphere

Equality

encouragement to get involved whatever your gender, background, race, ability, sexual preference or religion

Respect

relationships based on trust and honesty - you will be valued, listened to, and not judged

Information Advice & Guidance

support and help to make informed decisions about your life

Confidentiality

discussions that are confidential unless you are at risk of serious harm or harming others

Fun

opportunities that are fun, challenging and affordable

Safety

trained workers who are police checked and who risk assess all their work to ensure your safety

Responsibility

the chance to be fully involved in decision making and in the planning, delivery and outcomes of work. Encouraged to make positive changes benefiting you and your community

Progression

support to learn new skills as well as to move on into training, employment or further education when you are ready
